Practical Selection Day advice Dance BA (Hons)

Why do we ask you to participate in a Practical Selection Day

Dance requires specialist skills and an ability to collaborate effectively with other students. The Practical Selection Day gives us an opportunity to meet you in person and get an understanding of your personality and individuality as a dance artist. You will take part in a warm up workshop, present your solo and then have a one-to-one conversation with a member of the Dance course team. Seeing your solo performance gives us an idea of your performance skills. Speaking with you helps us understand if studying Dance at DMU will be the most enjoyable choice for you.

What are we looking for?

A passion for the subject, an ability to think critically and move con dently. In the performance of your solo, we will be looking for your potential to:

- Demonstrate co-ordination, technique and use of space
- · Create and con dently perform inventive solo choreography

In your discussion with a member of the dance team, we will be looking for your potential to:

- Talk about your interest in dance
- Discuss your experience of dance
- Be curious about other dance and creative practices

What can you do to prepare?

Prepare a short solo performance (maximum one to two minutes) this can be choreographed by you or you and a teacher. This solo can be a combination of styles/practices that feature on the course (Contemporary, Ballet for Contemporary, Africanist Principles/Jazz, Hip Hop/Street).

- Think about why you want to study this course and what appeals to you
- Read your application form and remind yourself of what you have said
- Watch some contemporary dance performances, and discuss them with us
- Try and relax we want you to have an enjoyable experience
